The following are trades made after the draft. This trading period ends on April 12. All trades made during this period apply before start of season on April 13, 1987. Note: Please remember that each team must have 550 AB for each position and 1400 IP for pitching staff. This is before the 10% rule is added on.

Trading Periods

Trades made before start of season are in effect at beginning of season. Trades made from start of season (April 13) to June 14 will go into effect for start of series 10 to end of season. Trades made after June 14 will apply to next year. Trades made before June 14 must be one for one, two for two, etc. after June 14 for next year no restrictions. Draft picks for next years draft (1988) may be traded any time. Draft picks past 1988 draft CAN NOT be traded until after the 88 draft.

Active/Inactive Roster

On April 13 please send your 25 man active list and 5 man inactive list to me for publication in the Newsletter. This roster will be in effect for series 1 thru series 9.

Each Series Report to League Presidents

After the completion of each series you are required to send Won-Lost record and game scores to your League President every other Monday. The League President will then be sending the league standing to you every other Monday. PENALTY POINTS will be issued for failure to perform this managerial duty.

What to send after series to other manager .

Each manager is required to send away team's individual player stats as well as away team's team totaled stats plus home team's team totaled stats. Each manager must send game by game highlights or individual game score sheets. It is strongly suggested that individual score sheets of each game be sent as a replacement for game highlights. PENALTY POINTS will be issued for failure to perform this managerial duty.

Instruction Addition

Since S-O-M has not seen fit to print individual advanced stealing ratings on each batters card. Each manager should send along with his instructions his team's advance stealing ratings for his batters. As you know it is a real hassle to look up each batter on the stealing chart. I would suggest that you write the ratings on our cards for easy reference.
