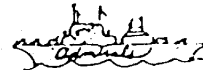

But after talking it over 1 & 2 are trying to do the same. Bunting for a base hit! If #2, is ok than #1, is ok. The squeeze has the better % for the hit. Make your feelings known on these matters so we all play by the same rules!(i do both for a base hit all the time.)

Duke: I'm writing you from San Diego. Vacation is ending in another week. I'll be home Aug. 22. I've voiced several complaints about the FBN. I like the league as it is the fairest I have ever played in. I have a better record on the road than at home. I recently graduated college. I have a new job as a tax consultant. I will be working 2-3 nights and weekends. I'll be late and I don't know if I'll be able to finish the season. I have a friend that could take co-ownership of the team. (Mgr. Weiss has asked me to contact him about this situation. I will add a person note to his Report.)

BRUNO'S BITS: The Red Skins have only won 23 of the last 57 games. At Jarheads down 1-0 in the 9th Griffey leads off with a single. Griffey takes his lead and he's off for second beating Ro Diaz's throw. Mgr. Bruno gives the bunt sign. Ozzie Guillen turns to bunt as Griffey starts running from second. Guillen misses the bunt and Griffey slides under the tag, stolen base. Bruno gives the squeeze sign. Griffey starts from third. Bedrosian pitches. Guillen turns late and.....misses the bunt. Griffey beats the pitch and is SAFT at home! Three stolen bases in one inning. Never done before by a Red Skin. I don't know if it was ever done before in the FBN. Oh, the game.
