Devil Doodies: (1) Thru series #9, Devils team batting average was a very modest .250 but pitching had an excellent 3.37 ERA. Record was 28-24.

Thru series #17, Devils batting average jumped to .271!! while pitching worsened slightly to 3.61. This increased offense directly led to their 63-51 record presently !! Also, 4 Blue Devils w/.300 or better averages. (Gwynn, Webster, Dykstra & Gantner)
