## INSIDE THE F-B-NBA

### DATES TO REMEMBER:

- 
- 02/18/89 - 1. GM's mail their written draft instructions & their phone number for the telephone draft to the commissioner.
- 02/26/89 - 1. **TELEPHONE DRAFT DAY.**  
2. Preseason trading begins.
- 02/26/89 - 1. Undrafted players become available to all GM's. Call the Commissioner if you're interested in claiming anyone.
- 03/12/89 - 1. Preseason trading ends at 9PM Eastern time. If Commissioner is called with a trade after 9PM he will disallow the trade.
- 03/13/89 - 1. GM's mail their 1325 IP & 500 AB rosters to their league president and a copy to the commissioner.  
Note: Follow same procedure as you did for protected rosters.
- 03/20/89 - 1. Commissioner mails out a copy of the draft results along with the OPENING DAY rosters to all GM's.
- 03/27/89 - 1. **OPENING DAY 1989!**
- 04/10/89 - 1. First seasonal trading period begins.
- 

### The following are the draft day instructions.

1. The draft will take place in Norwich, Ct., on Sunday <sup>Feb 26</sup> March 5th. The draft will begin at 12 noon Eastern, 11:00 AM Central & 9:00 AM Pacific.
2. The first call will be made by the Commissioner to you. This is to establish contact and to receive your first pick. From the 9th pick in round one we will be using the "Buddy System". After you give me your selection I may give you the name of a manager for you to call & let that manager know of all the selections that I told you plus your pick. MAKE sure you have your Manager Directory handy!
3. On each draft pick after the first I will call and let the phone ring twice and hangup. DO NOT PICKUP THE PHONE! You will then have one (1) minute to call me back at 1-203-889-3815. I will then inform you of each player which has been drafted since your last selection (Hopefully 6 to 7 players max!).
4. You will then have one (1) minute to make your selection.

This procedure will continue until the completion of the draft.

### Draft day note:

Both presidents have called me about the long hours of the draft. Last year the draft took 7 hours! And we were lucky to have 10 managers present on draft day. What would happened if a commissioner only had 2 or 3 people present? We decided something had to be done to cut down on the number of hours. We came up with the "Buddy System". It will cost you a few dollars BUT it should SAVE you 2 or 3 HOURS of time!!!!!!!!!!!!

I'll be in Norwich at 11 AM.

From New York: 95 North to 395 North to exit 82 (Yantic-Norwichtown). At end of ramp take left. 4/10's of a mile down on left is Yantic River Plaza. Liberty Mutual is last building in lot.

From Vermont: 91 to Hartford. Look for route 84 East (East Hartford) Also look for signs for route 2 (Norwich-New London). Follow Rte. 2 all the way to NORWICH. At end of Rte 2 it will merge with Rte 32. Take exit 27 (Yantic-Willimantic). At second light take right into Yantic River Plaza.

From Salem: West towards New York. Route 93 to 495 to route 90 to 395 south at Auburn. Follow 395 to Exit 82 (Willimantic-Hartford). At end of ramp take right. 4/10's of a mile down on left is Yantic River Plaza.
