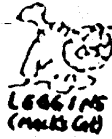

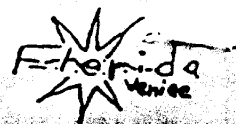

- 01/01/90 = 1. Mail check to SOM for the new cards.
- 02/05/90 = 1. Winter Meetings open. Winter Trading Period begins. [ends 02/04]
- 02/12/90 = 1. Commissioner mails protected rosters to all GM's.
- 02/19/90 = 1. GM's mail their written draft instructions & their phone number for the telephone draft to the commissioner.
- 02/25/90 = 1. **DRAFT DAY**
- 02/26/90 = 1. Undrafted players become available to all GM's. Call the commissioner if you're interested in claiming anyone.
- 03/05/90 = 1. Commissioner mails out the draft results to all GM's.
- 03/11/90 = 1. Undrafted player selection ends at 6PM EST. Any calls after 6PM EST will be disallowed. Call the commissioner to see if you picked up your player.

2. Limit instructions to 1 page - back and front! To include 25 active roster AND all inactive players currently owned.
3. Use a standard RI format. This way all managers when receiving RI will know exactly where to look for the appropriate situation on this standard sheet instead of spending time hunting through complicated styles of RI. Once standard is drafted all managers would just have to fill in the appropriate "blanks" left for various situations like lineups, stealing ect.
4. Eliminate wins and losses to determine standings.(Use pt. sys)
5. Make it mandatory to include Home/Away record in the standings.
6. Do not use pitcher's holding rating when deciding a steal.....
7. Make HBP an official statistic.....
8. Schedule changed to 32 Series.....
- 8b. Keep schedule at 27 Series.....
9. On a hit without an asterick: when throw is not cutoff trailing runner would only advance after a 20-sided die is rolled. If roll result falls within the trailing runners RUNNING RATING, he would move up a base. If it does not fall within his RUNNING RATING, he would not advance the extra base. NO OUT IS INVOLVED IN THIS CHANGE.
10. When a team becomes available in the FBN: It will be offered first to the present members. If a present member wants the team he must give up his team. If more than one present member wants the team a re-entry draft will be held including all the teams plus the backup manager who will be the newest member to the FBN.
11. When a team does become available to a backup manager; the -BP rating form the old team:
1. remains intact..... PICK ONE
2. is reduced by 50%.....
3. is removed completely.....
4. will be based on the new managers -BP rating listed below.....
- a. If new manager has 0BP.....: Old -BPs removed completely.
- b. " " " -1BP to -3BP: Old -BPs reduced by 75%.
- c. " " " -4BP to -7BP: Old -BPs reduced by 50%.
- d. " " " -7BP.....: No reduction on old -BPs.

- 12.If a team or teams become available at the end of a season and a re-entry draft is planned a present manager will have the option to disband his team & be included in the re-entry draft. []
- 13.Managers will be able to pick-up an undrafted player(s) going into last block of series. For each player picked-up one must be released. []
- 14.Allow a starting pitcher who's pitched less than 3 innings in his previous start to come back one day earlier than currently permitted. An asterisked starter could start on 2 day's rest, a non-asterisked starter on 3 day's rest. []
- 15.Eliminate the complete ballpark rating change every two years with a +/- 2 change the second year. Change to: Ballparks can be changed +/- 5 every year. Keep ranges the same. Teams picked up midseason inherit old Ballpark rate. Only re-entry draft teams start fresh. []
- 16.Play by the official SOM advanced rule for PB, WP, and Balks. []
- 17.Advancement to 3rd on flyballs. Use the following tagging up at 2nd chart. []

- 18.Eliminate the DH in 1991.....[]
- 19.A poor team with 1 -BP would draft somewhere around pick number 30 in the second round. That is a net loss of 9 places in the draft. A good team with a lot of points would picking number 38 would only lose a total of 2 places in the draft at number 40. An alternate system would be to assess -BP's from the original point in the draft. Example: a team drafting #24 in the second round with 2 -BP's would move to #26. A team drafting #38 in the round with 10 points would move down to # 48. In cases of a tie the team with the worst record would go first. This would not affect teams without any -BP's, and it would penalize teams more with respect to the magnitude of the points against them. []
- 20.For all award voting each team nominate a player at each position and submit nominations with player's stats to President. []
- 21.Change the special FBN rule for infield in without a man on third such that a groundball A, B, or C be treated as a standard Groundball B. []
- 22.For new teams that are established during the off season they be given draft picks behind established teams on odd rounds. On even rounds, they be assigned draft picks behind established teams without -BP's. []
