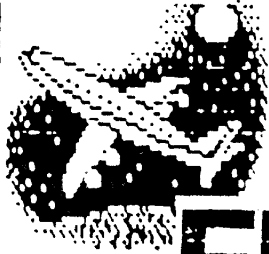
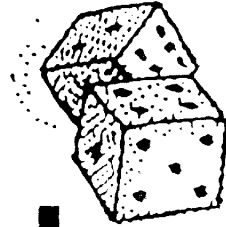

Somewhat for real..... Representatives of the FBNBA and major league baseball began the process of drafting a new standard player development contract.

The executive committee will meet August 11, at FBNBA league headquarters in Norwich. The committee was formed by President Gineo and GM Mendez with the approval of the commissioner. The standard PDC allows a maximum of 35, players on a FBN league club roster following the draft. With major league baseball expanding by two teams in 1992, the new PDC may allow 38, players on a FBN league club roster following the draft. The addition of three players per team MAY eliminate the need of the extra 10% rule.

This radical change would need a majority vote by league members. League officials would like to wrap up an agreement by November 1990. "This would allow teams to plan for the future" said Commissioner Bruno.

.....Would you like to expand post draft rosters from 35 to 38 when baseball expands? Just something to think about. IP would move up to 1500, and AB's would move up to 550.

All for fun.....Commissioner BruVINCENT rules on the BruSTEINBRENNER case. "BruSTEINBRENNER is still the "Boss" of the 89ers." No action will be taken against BruSTEINBRENNER or the 89ers.
