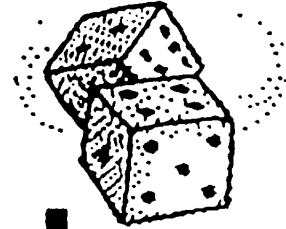

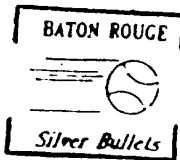

NINER NOTES - The 89ers are trying to play the roll of the spoiler. Allyn Street takes 4 of 6 from Willimantic (taking series 10-8) and splits with the U. S. Jarheads. "You're really beating me when I can't afford it!", said Manager Bill Nieman. Jarheads took 12 out of 18 for the season series. Despite the split, the Jarheads held on to second place.

Jim Deshaies has 3 starts remaining and needs to win all three to get the elusive 20 win season!!

COW CHEWS - The Mystic Holsteins are smoking red hot !! They have just completed winning nine straight !! Highlights include shutouts by Saberhagen, Clemens, and Scott. Greg Litton is batting .382 with 4 HR's since his acquisition from the Dragons. Mystic is 45-27 since the midpoint of the season.

JARHEAD SCUTTLEBUTT - Lonnie Smith reaches a "double triple" in walks and strikeouts; 102 BB's and 106 K's. With 12 games remaining, Smith needs 9 RBI's to make it a "triple, triple."

The vaunted Klubber pitching staff was no match for Hawk hitters as they kept the NL East leaders to less than five runs in only one game, a game in which the Klubbers were shut out.
