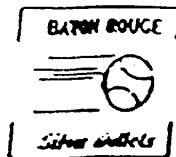

**News about the "new cards":** By now you know the "new cards" may not be out until the end of February. I've talked with everyone in the league about "drafting without the cards." The vote was 17-3, to draft without the cards. I'll call SOM Feb. 8th, if the cards are not out by then. If they say the cards are due out any day we will go ahead with Feb. 17th as planned and draft with the cards. But, if they tell me the cards may not be out until the last week of February or the 1st of March we will draft on the 17th without the cards. Hopefully, this will not happen.

I recommend that we make preparations to draft without the cards just in case. I recommend you send for John Lamanna's "Baseball Bulletin". The price is \$6. You can get the actual HITS and OBP that each player with a card will have. That's right, SOM sends John the facts for his Bulletin before the cards are even produced. Lamanna's Baseball Bulletin PO Box 271 Goldenrod, FL 32722-0271. With the Bill James (and we all now have a copy) and the "Bulletin" we will be able to draft without the cards. The Bulletin will have every player listed that will have a card. We will use it as our roster. But, if it includes the extra 63 player cards we will use 40 IP and 50 AB's as our minimum limits for a player to be available for our draft.

Lets hope SOM will make our day!

Now the good news. Enclosed you will find your 1991 schedule, 9 trade slips, 3 Team Report forms ( please make sure you use these when reporting your 54, 112 and 162 games. Some members have been using their own computer printouts. These have been to light to photo copy and some have needed two sides to get batting and pitching information.) 2 Won/Lost Report forms, a Constitution and dates to remember.

It is very important during the next few months that everyone be on time or early with reporting. Lateness at this time would kill us. Please, no minus bonus points!

January 21st is the next important date to follow. Mail me your protected roster, the phone number where you will be at on DRAFT DAY, the draft picks you own and the draft picks that you traded away.

Here is a simple away to determine the maximum players you can protect going into the draft: If you trade a draft pick, you must use your next regular draft position in the following round to draft a player. **EXAMPLE:** Allyn Street traded its #5 to Willimantic. The 89ers can only protect the number of players it will take to get to ITS regular pick in ROUND SIX. (Allyn Street's maximum protected roster is 29.)

The FBNBA sets schedule for its coming season.

## Dates to Remember for 1991:

- 01/20/91: Winter Trading Period ends at 9PM EST.(No other trades allowed until draft day.)
- 01/21/91: GM's mail protected rosters, draft picks owned, draft picks traded away and the phone number for DRAFT DAY to the commissioner.
- 01/28/91: 1. Commissioner mails protected rosters and the official draft order to GM's.
- 02/04/91: 1. GM's mail written draft instructions to the Commissioner.
- 02/17/91: 1. **DRAFT DAY**. DRAFT NUMBER: 1-203-889-3815. (NON-DRAFT line 1-203-889-3817)  
2. Preseason Trading begins.
- 02/18/91: Undrafted players become available to all GM's. Call commissioner for selection.
- 02/25/91: Commissioner mails out the draft results to all GM's.
- 03/04/91: Undrafted player selection ends at 6PM EST.
- 03/05/91: 1. GM's mail their 1325 IP & 500 AB's to their league president (list limits before the extra 10% is added on).  
2. GM's mail a copy of the IP & AB limits to the commissioner.  
3. GM's mail opening day rosters (active and inactive) to commissioner.  
4. GM's mail ballpark ratings to commissioner.  
5. First Seasonal Trading Period begins. (Trades effective 1st game of series #5.)
- 03/12/91: Commissioner mails out the Opening Day Rosters to GM's.
- 03/25/91: **OPENING DAY 1991.**
