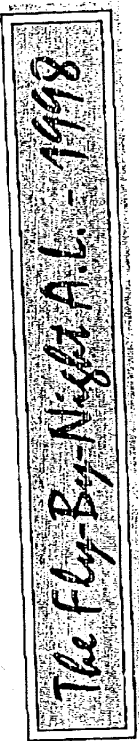

President - Jeff Merfina Report Date: 10/15/98

Marysville, OH (AP) - Another great season of the FBN is in the books. Congratulations to everyone for a job well done. It was an exciting season with many records being broken.

1. The Bats' Jay Buhner broke the FBN (and, of course, AL) record with 202 whiffs. In a duel that was second only to the real life McGwire-Sosa race, he nosed out Melvin Nieves of Mid-Maine, who finished a disappointing 2nd despite breaking the old record himself with 195 strikeouts. The previous record holder was Jesse Barfield of the 1991 Baton Rouge Silver Bullets.
2. BR's Curt Schilling broke the FBN (and AL) record in a positive way with 369 punch outs. The old record holder was soon-to-be-Admiral Randy Johnson (364 with the 1996 Hogsites).
3. Jamie Navarro of Hotlanta broke 2 dubious AL records, losing 25 games (6-25 overall) and giving up 167 earned runs in the process. The old AL loss record was held by 4 players, and the ER record was held by Danny Jackson of the 1995 Whippets.

Other interesting stats were as follows:

1. Mid-Maine hitters worked only 402 walks from opposing pitchers, while Mussel-Men hurlers gave up 777 free passes. I do not ever remember seeing a gain so wide on one team.
2. Hotlanta may have lost 102 games, and had a horrible OBP, but they were fun to watch when they did get on, piffing 188 bases as a team.
3. The Florida Sun hit .301 as a team.
4. Mike Mussina led the league in dongs allowed with 38. Dave Hollins of Yorktown butchered 33 grounders to lead the league.

Salem had a whopping 1347 whiffs as a team, but only committed 70 errors.
 6. Carlos Hernandez (Yorktown) had 145 at bats without a walk.

After hitting 52 HRs in 1998 Mark McGwire now has 432 for his FBK career. Big Mac has a shot at reaching 500 next yr! He has 160 in 3 years as a Hog.....that's getting your money's worth.

The Hogs have traded Doc Gooden to the Admirals. The Good Doctor was one of the two remaining Hogs from the inaugural 1993 season. Doc best season was 1994 when he won 21 games. Now, the only original Hog is Tony Fernandez. Gooden joins Dave Magadan, Walk Weis, Dave Burba, Randy Johnson, Dave Martinez and Greg Swindell in the group of Hogs traded away for next year. The 1999 Hogs will look a whole lot different.....not as good, but a much younger.

The retcoiling Hogs are also interested in trading Fernandez along with Paul O'Neill, Jeff Reed, Jim Lyrizt and Jamie Moyer. Jeff Shaw and Mike Timlin could also be had, but I'm inclined to hold onto them.

PLAYOFFS

The Hogs defeated an excellent Arsenal team in the first round of the playoffs. I'm sure that Dean would concur that it was some very fortuitous rolls that contributed to the Hogs victory. I thought that the Gunners would win the series, but as the old adage says "it's better to be lucky than good". Dean and I debated for about a half hour as to which team was better in a short series....each of us saying the other team was better. I guess I lost the debate but won the war. The Hogs won the series 4-1. Randy Johnson had two complete game victories and was named series MVP. The Hogs good fortune continued against the Sun. The Hogs pitching was great holding a terrifying Sun lineup to an average of less than 4 runs a game. The Sun out hit the Hogs in practically every game, but they failed repeatedly in the clutch while the Hogs' hits came timely and in bunches. The most timely of course was Big Mac's homer with two outs in the bottom of the 9th of game six. The McGwire blast (a 1-5 ball-parker) broke a 3-3 deadlock and sent the Hogs on to the World Series. The Hogs won the series 4-2. The series MVP went to Jeff Shaw who secured 3 of the Hogs wins and pitched 7 scoreless innings. In game six Shaw pitched out of 1st & 3rd and 2nd & 3rd, 1 out jams in the 8th and 9th innings of a 3-3 game. It was his heroics that set the stage for McGwire's blast.

Baton Rouge Notes

What a season! What an improbable ending!!! The final series against both the Hogs and Salem was marked by the unheard of players coming through in a big way. Marreco hitting a slam with 2 out in the bottom of the 9th to beat the Hogs 6-5, another homer (1-5 ball parker) to win another game over the Hogs in the bottom of the 9th, and a run scoring double by Keith Osiak in the 10th to beat Salem in the decisive 5th game of that series (preceded by a 3 run homer by Zaun in the 8th and a 2 run double by Rod Butler in the 9th). We are going to the playoffs but you have to feel for Rich who won 104 games and sits.

Going to 6 divisions (if you guys vote it in) won't eliminate the chance of having 3 great teams in one division but it would be less likely than with 4 divisions. That is why I proposed the new schedule. I was in Rich's exact position a couple years ago with 97 wins, so it does happen not infrequently.

The team MVP for 1998 has to be Curt Schilling who was 25-9 with a 2.54 ERA and 369 strikeouts in 279 innings. All of those are team records - Wins, ERA, Ks and Innings pitched. The hitting stars were Lofton (.334 avg), Thome (31 dingers, 111 RBI) and Sheffield (36 HR, 118 runs). Greg Zaun, called up for only the last two rounds of games, was outstanding with a .353 avg, .468 OB and .510 SP. Rob Ducey's .325 avg and .554 SP was also outstanding for a part-timer.

The Bullets finished the regular season with a tremendous burst of (luck) wins to edge a deserving Salem team and head on to the post-season. However, that was the last of the (luck) wins as Baton Rouge faced a good Florida team. With the hitting star being Hundley with a .308 average (no homers) leading a team who hit .198 and a pitching staff with a 6.30 ERA lead by Schilling with a 12.66 ERA, 2 losses and 7 homers given up, it is easy to see why we sent 0-4. Schilling's team MVP looks a little tarnished. That said but not forgotten, the Bullets had a fine season, surpassing my expectations. The 105 wins are in fact this franchise's best record. Winning 49 games on the road was certainly the key to such a fine season.

During this season, while racking up 112 wins, the Hogs went 7-11 against both Salem and Baton Rouge... and I think they won because of the HRs. Mel Nieves lucked his way to a .261 BA in between all the K's and Martin, Damon and Sweeney all had decent seasons. A-Rod the clod finished with a dismal .256 BA and slugged a pathetic .391. Cirillo's BA was OK at .269 but he managed only 40 2B's and 65 RBIs with a great clutch card.
