Jan 29 - It's that time of year again... The race is on to the Draft! Enclosed are the Protected Rosters. The next important date to remember is Feb. 15. GM's must mail in their written draft instructions and the phone number that they will be at on draft day to the Commissioner. Mark on the outside of the envelope "DRAFT INSTRUCTIONS"

This envelope will only be opened at the draft if for some reason we can not reach you during the draft. Let's hope for good weather.

Feb. 21 - Draft Day. The draft will start at 11:00AM. I will call you and let the phone ring twice and I will hang up. *Please do not pick up the phone.* You will have two minutes to call back at 1-860-889-3813.

EMAIL to be Used: We will be trying email for the first time in place of the "buddy system" for everyone except Chris Gager in Maine.

We hope this will give the away GM's more time in reviewing their needs before each selection.

Baton Rouge - The trades of Ron Gant, Rafael Palmeiro and Mark Lewis and the imminent cut of Jim Eisenreich greatly changes the face of the Silver Bullets and marks the first major move to rejuvenate this team. Palmeiro was drafted as a rookie in 1988 and leads every hitters category in the Baton Rouge team career statistics book except triples, errors, stolen bases and out stealing. His career totals are 1612 games played, 6136 ABs, 885 runs, 1785 hits, 368 doubles, 236 home runs, 1037 RBI, 588 walks and 822 Ks - all BR records. He has a career .291 average, .353 on base and .478 slugging. Jim Eisenreich is second to Palmeiro in games played with 1135. Eisenreich was a diamond found in the 9th round of the.... Baton Rouge, a changing team.

1988 draft. It took a couple years for him to solve his Tourettes syndrome but he has been a critical part of Baton Rouge's success over the past several years. He hit .362 in 1994, .353 in 1996 and .384 in 1997 and has a career .318 batting average - only one point behind Kenny Loftons leading .319 career average. Ron Gant was acquired from Lake Wobegon for Mike Devereaux in 1993. His was an up and down career with 1994, 1996 and 1997 being big years with a total of 98 homers and 273 RBI. Mark Lewis was perhaps the biggest disappointment in team history. He was drafted in 1992 as the #2 pick just ahead of Ivan Rodriguez to fill the shortstop position for the next 15 years. Scott Fletcher just couldn't cut the mustard. In 7 seasons he played 601 games with a .253 average. He holds the FBN AL record for most errors in a season with 39.

"It remains to be seen what will be obtained to replace these guys. Rondell White should be a good one. The rest are draft picks. We shall see.. Hopefully there are no more Mark Lewis's in my future." said GM Holbrook.

With these guys gone and Hundley and Alex Fernandez out for the season the Bullets will have a different look. Three big lefties from our normal lineup will be gone - Palmeiro, Hundley and Eisenreich. Hopefully Hundley can come back and at least hit. Fernandez will be sorely missed in the rotation as well.

January is always the dead season for baseball news, so GM and Owner-for-Life Klee usually likes to liven things up by going to Glen Head, Long Island to pick up the latest set of Strat cards. This urge is particularly strong when the Klubbers may actually be good.

Friday January 22nd was a grey day with a threat of rain and temperatures in the 40's, typical for the January Thaw in the Northeast. The Klubkar was showing its age with a balky starter (similar to anyone in the Klubber rotation the last several years) but Klee decided to risk the trip and met Jarhead owner Bill Nieman at a Park & Ride lot on the Bridgeport-Strat(1)ford line. Klee then jumped into the ex-Marine's land blimp for the two hour journey to Mecca.
