Dec. 20, 1999 1. Order the cards..

Jan. 02, 2000 - 1. Winter Meetings open. Trading allowed until Jan 30.

Jan. 21 - 1. Opening Day at SOM.

Jan. 30 - 1. Winter Meetings close at 06:00pm Eastern Time. No trades can be announced until after the draft.

2. GM's email or mail in protected rosters and draft picks owned. Include the ML team that is on the players card. List batters and pitchers separately and in alphabetical order.

Feb 07 - Commissioner mails out protected rosters and official draft order.

Feb. 11 - GM's mail in draft instructions and the phone number that they will be at for the draft. Mark on the envelope "DRAFT INSTRUCTIONS". This envelope will only be opened at the draft if for some reason you can not be reached on draft day. Mail in the instructions even if you plan on being at the draft in person or on line.

Feb 20 Draft Day 2000

1. The draft will start 11:00am. I will call you and let the phone ring twice and I will hang up. PLEASE DONOT PICK UP. You will have two minutes

Yorktown jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the 3rd as Mark McGwire made his presence known with a 3 run blast. Salem got 3 back in the 4th and 1 in the 5th before Ray Durham tied it with a solo shot in the 7th as the 1st batter to face Gil Heredia in to relieve Radke.

That's the way it stayed until the 10 when Andres Gallaraga hit a 3 run homer off of Mike Williams and Mike Jackson held on to give Salem a 3 games to none lead.

The rematch of Brown and Johnson was more like you'd expect as both pitchers were tough. Johnson was back on his game and repeated something he'd done a number of times when he pitched for Caribou St., striking out 18. Yorktown had many more chances but couldn't crack Brown, stranding 10 runners and hitting into 4 double plays including one to end Yorktown's season. Brown was strong for 7 1/3 before tiring. Gabe White had to come in with Salem's bullpen depleted from games #2 and #3 but he was able to do the job. The story in this series was pitching, especially Salem's as Yorktown only scored 6 runs in 4 games plus 9 extra innings. Salem's offense wasn't great either after the amazing 21 run outburst in the 1st game. From Yorktown's side, McGwire hit OK but only had one homer and Martinez did nothing. Salem's Mo Vaughn and Carlos Delgado were mostly ineffective as well but Andres Gallaraga produced well and continued to be a big force since his arrival in Salem.

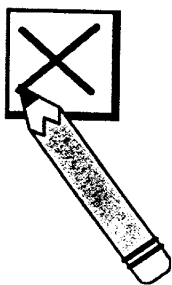
