## COMMISSIONERS NOTE:

We have lost Ed Graboski and Dave Sanborn. Ed did not have the time and Dave has been having personal issues.

At this time we do not have a manager for the Arizona team but this may change on Monday. If you know someone who is interested let me know. I will also put an advisement in the SOM world. We plan on taking our time to find a good manager.

I was waiting to send this newsletter hoping that I would have filled the second managers opening. This did not happen.

## Commissioner and League Presidents have made the following League decisions.

1. Don and Glen Boucher (acting as GM for the Arizona team, will participate in a re-draft from the Eastern and Arizona rosters. Don will be given the Eastern Pointers place in the re-entry draft and the 2009 draft. So the old EP #5 that has been traded to Salem will be based on Don's final record. The re-entry draft will be as if Eastern and Arizona has made a mega trade with each other.
2. Don will be in the NL East. Arizona will remain in the AL West.
3. Both "new" teams will start playing games block 6, July 12. Don will run his team while I play the Arizona games. I will not play any Arizona games by NETPLAY. All Arizona home games will be played by computer. For Arizona road games I will send out RI.
4. Both teams will be given 2009 draft picks for all rounds. They will own the next to last and last draft pick in each round. Don will own the next to last in the odd rounds and Arizona will own the next to last in the even rounds.
5. Any draft picks that have been trade to Ed Graboski or to Dave Sanborn will be eliminated from the draft.
6. The draft picks that Dave Sanborn traded to CD, HS and CT will continue to carry the 23 -BP's. The placement for these DP's will be added to the new Arizona team finish.
7. Milford will still owe Arizona's #1 DP with no -Bp's.
8. EP#5 that was traded to Salem will be based on Don Decker's team's final record.

We will ultimately end up with 25 picks in the first 5 rounds.

**We believe this is the best possible solution to this mess. We think this works fair for all parties and is in the "best interest of the FBNBA."**

**Don and his Norwich Navigators** will start playing July 12th. Don after you complete the re-entry draft please email my your roster and your ballpark size plus if you have high or low walls. Here are the other members ballparks to give you an idea.....

Glen will email me **the "new" Arizona Team** roster after the re-entry draft. I will play the Arizona home games and I'll send out RI for the away games starting July 12th.

FYI - for other members to see here are the re-entry draft rules..... (Glen will draft first as he won the coin toss.)

Each team **MUST** have a minimum of 500 AB's and 1325 IP at the end of the re-entry draft.

1. You must draft all eight fielding positions plus four starting pitchers plus four relief pitchers before you can draft a second player at the same fielding position or before you can draft a fifth starting pitcher or a fifth relief pitcher. You can draft these players in any order you wish but you must have a catcher, first baseman, second baseman, third baseman, short stop, left fielder, center fielder and a right fielder plus four starting pitchers and 4 relievers on your roster **BEFORE** you can add another fielder or a 5th starter or 5th reliever.

Once you have the first 16 players completed you can draft anyone you want in any order. **REMEMBER** to must have a minimum of 500 AB's for the 8 fielding positions and a minimum of 1325 innings when the re-entry draft is complete.

2. At the end of the re-entry draft email me your rosters with the AB's listed for each position and list the total innings that you have.

**NO TRADES WILL BE ALLOWED BETWEEN NORWICH AND THE 22 ESTABLISHED FBN TEAMS FOR FIVE DAYS AFTER THE RE-ENTRY. THIS WILL GIVE THE DON TIME TO GET TO KNOW OUR RULES PLUS GIVE ME TIME TO GET ALL THE AB'S AND IP STATS TOGETHER.**

3. All players traded from the two new teams to an established FBN team will be limited strictly by the 110% AB's and IP limitations.

California: #2 to MD. #5 to UR. Also, CT#4 to TX. CT#5 to IL.

Connecticut: #1 & #2 to NE. #4 to CD. #5 to CD.

Eastern: #5 to SP.

Florida: #1 to NE. #2 MC.

Hart Street: #1 to MC. #2 to KK. #3 to IL. #4 to IL. #5 to UR. Also, NE#3 to WS. IL#4 to MC. AB#3(-23BP's) to UR.

Illinois: #2 to MC. #3 to USJ. #4 to HS.

Klee's: #3 to MD. Also, MC#1 & HS#2 to MD.

Maine: #5 to MD.

Middlesex: #1 to KK. #2 SP. #4 to HS. Also, SP#2 to FS. HS#1 to IL.

Milford: #1 to MC. #3 to AB. #4 to IL.

New England: #3 to HS.

Salem: #1 to NE. #2 to MC. #3 to KK. #4 to FS. Also, WS#4 to NE.

Taxachusetts: #1 to BR. #2 to HT. #3 LW.

Urpaign: #1 to MD.

Wall Street: #4 to SP.

Yorktown: #5 to CT.
