COMMISSIONERS NOTE:

As everyone is aware by now Don Decker and Glen Boucher held a re-entry draft of the old Eastern and Arizona rosters. Don will start playing block 6, July 12.

NEWS FLASH: Also, effective Block 6, Dan Patriss and the Fly-By-Night Baseball Association have made an agreement in principal. Dan will be the new owner of the Arizona Bats. He will be the active GM making trades for his team effective immediately. I will be playing the Arizona games for the rest of the 2008 season. When you email or mail me your RI please do it based on the computer manager tendencies. Do not export a computer manager to me because I can not import them into the game. Larry Huck, if you have games away with AB just send me regular written RI.

Starting July 12th Don Decker will take over the Eastern Pointers season. Don will be limited to 40% of the official FBN At Bats and Innings Pitched allowed for each player on his roster. (Example - a player on the EP re-entry roster will have his AB or IP time's 110% x 40% (balance of the season).

Player "XYZ" has 568 AB on his card. $568 \times 110\% = 635$ FBN AB's. $635 \times 40\% = 254$ Remaining AB's for the 2008 season.

Player "ABC" has 41IP on his card. $41 \times 110\% = 45$ FBN IP. $45 \times 40\% = 18$ Remaining IP for the 2008 season.

This rule will apply to any player traded from Don's re-entry roster to another team before July 12. Once Don starts playing games and he trades a player that he has used he must send those stats to the new team. The new team will have the 40% minus any AB's or IP'ed used by Don.

A player that is traded to Don will be limited to his normal FBN usage. The team trading the player to Don must send him the player stats. If Don then trades an establish player from his team to another the actual usage for 2008 must be sent to the new team. **THE ABOVE 40% RULE IS FOR THE RE-ENTRY PLAYERS ONLY.**
