Reminder:

Eastern Pointer/Norwich Navigators will be limited to 40% of the official FBN At Bats and Innings Pitched allowed for each player on his roster.

A player traded from Eastern/Norwich or from Arizona must have the player stats from block 6 sent to the new team. The new team will limited to the 40% minus any AB's or IP'ed used by Eastern/Norwich or Arizona.

A player that is traded to Eastern/Norwich or Arizona will be limited to his normal FBN usage. The team trading the player to Eastern/Norwich or Arizona must send Don or me (I'm keeping the Arizona stats. Dan is the GM) the player stats. If Eastern/Norwich or Arizona than trades an establish player from his team to another the actual usage for 2008 must be sent to the new team. **THE ABOVE 40% RULE IS FOR THE RE-ENTRY PLAYERS ONLY.**
