2008 All-Star Game - James Shields (NL) vs. Fausto Carmona (AL)

The AL loads the bases with none out in the 2nd, but Shields limits the damage to a Rollins Sac Fly. The score remains 1-0 until the 5th inning when NL catcher Posada leads off with a flyball to Guerrero who plays it into a triple. The next batter, Pujols, launches one over the Blue Dwarf (against Peavy in his 3rd inning of relief). The NL then loads the bases with one out. Haren gets Sizemore to fly to Ichiro who runs in to make the catch and hold the runner at 3rd. Bedard comes in to face Holliday with the bags juiced and two out - Holliday chokes in the clutch!

The game remains 2-1 NL until Russell Martin ties it with a PH HR off Perez to lead off the bottom of the 7th. Still 2-2 in the bottom of the 8th, the AL gets the 1st two men on against Jenks. But Vlady grounds into a DP and Hawpe flies out.
