Norwich at Klee's:

"After a series loss to the "Snow Birds" of New England, we had to bounce back. Lucky for us our next trip was at Jim Bouton Field", said Connie Mack. "Twenty shutout innings from the SPs in three games did the trick. Thank goodness that Mr. Griffen picked the Klubbers to make the playoffs. What did he say? He broke one of his cardinal rules? Lucky for the rest of the FBN," said Mack. Norwich took all 4 games to get healthy again.

Navigators party into the night after the sweep of Klee's, arrive hungover to the park vs the hungry Devils. Devils score 33 runs to Gators 15. "We lost 3 but still ended up 5-3 after the two series", said Mack.

School Yard News:

The 89ERS finished Block I with a split at Illinois. With the split the 89ERS finished at 10-10. "Not earth shattering but at this stage of the season we'll take it", said Casey Stengel. Kevin Newman is leading the team batting .391, .400 OBP, .522 SLG with 11 runs, 5 doubles, 2 triples and 7 stolen bases. Jean Segura is batting .324 with 2 HR and a .500 SLG. Rookie Tim Locastro is hitting .300 in limited action. "The kid will see more starting time going into the next group of games", said Casey.

Trevor Bauer has gotten off to a good start at 3-1, 2.64 ERA with 34K's in 27.1 innings. Bauer climbing the Allyn Street All-Time leaders list. With his second win of the season Bauer has passed Dustin Hermanson for 8th place with 75 wins. In his next start which was at Illinois he passed Ramon Ortiz for 10th with 145 starts. He is now just 14 starts behind Jim Deshaies (159). After a win at Illinois, his third of the season, Bauer is now just one win behind Josh Johnson for 7th. Bauer is also closing in on Josh Johnson for 7th place on the K's list. Bauer needs 26 more to pass Johnson.

Two pitchers acquired in trades before the season started have anchored the starting staff along with Bauer. Masahiro Tanaka is enjoying a fine start with the 89ERS going 2-1, 2.74ERA. Kevin Gausman's record is 1-2. It surely is not an indication of how well he's pitched. Gausman is leading the staff with a 2.56ERA. He has 31K's in 24.2 innings. Both of his losses have been by 1 run. He lost 3-2 to Maine and 5-4 to Burlington. He was trailing 3-1 when he was removed in the Burlington game. While Tyler Mahle is 2-2 with a 5.02 ERA and CC Sabathia is 2-2 with a 6.86 ERA. No one said, baseball is fair. For Block II Sabathia will be rested. The veteran will see action in Block III against the American League.
