In a series with Lake Wobegon, the Chiefs hit .366 and scored 27



runs. The Taxmen are averaging 6.75 runs pergame. DJ was hot as ever going 10 for 14, with 3 HRs. LeMahieu (2b-1e5) is emerging as an early MVP candidate (.374, 64 RBI in 63 games). In their next series, the Taxmen come back to take 3 of 4 at Wall Street. "We just kept swinging the bats and didn't give up," said manager Joe Carter. "If you just keep trying good things can happen!"
