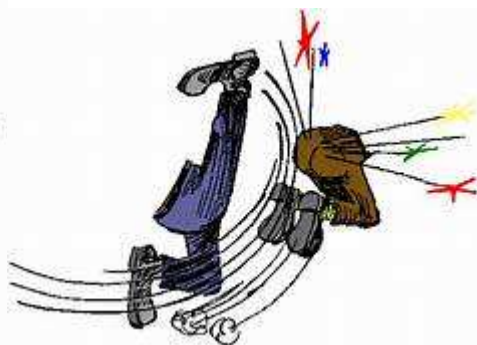
League News:
