

SERIES STATS ON NETPLAY

Here is another Netplay tip. You may already know this, but for those who don't, you can get to your Subsets after a Netplay series from the non hosting computer. You don't have to wait for your opponent to e-mail the Subset. Here is how to do this.

- Upon completion of the Netplay series and the "Game Over" is complete, highlight your team.
- Select "Statistics" on the top menu.
- Select "View game results".
- When the window opens at the top of the window it will come up "Look In" and show "Subsets". You DO NOT want this "Subsets".
- Click the home plate icon to the right.
- Highlight "Strat-O-Matic Baseball".
- Then scroll down and highlight the "Netplay" folder.
- Click "Open".
- Highlight "Subsets"
- Click "Open". You should see two subsets. One will be for your team and the other your opponent for the Netplay series just played.
- Open your Subset and then either print it or save it.
- You can also get to the Boxscores using this method. Follow the same steps to get to the Netplay Folder, but then select the "Print Folder" instead of the "Subset Folder."

If you use the computer to compile your team stats you can import the game files from the Netplay series and the stats get updated automatically (no manual entries). To do this:

- Upon completion of the Netplay series and the "Game Over" is complete, highlight your team.
- Select "Statistics" on the top menu.
- Select "Import game results".
- When the window opens at the top of the window it will come up "Look In" and show "Import". You DO NOT want this "Import".
- Click the home plate icon to the right.
- Highlight "Strat-O-Matic Baseball".
- Then scroll down and highlight the "Netplay" folder.
- Click "Open".
- Highlight "Export".
- Click "open".
- Highlight a "Game File" and click "open".
- Select and Click "Yes to all".
- Click "Import".
- You should get a message saying "Successfully imported" and your stats should be all updated at this point.
